Advocate in Poland (1982- 2016). Historical-legal study

Analysis in dissertation dissertation was conducted in 5 chapters.

Chapter 1 provides an analysis of the history of the lawyer from the beginning of Polish rule to the partitions. Chapter 2 presents the legal nature of the advocates' self-government during the interwar years, the Second World War and the latest history of the lawyers from the post-war period until 1982. A separate subsection is devoted to the Law of Attorney of 26 May 1982 - its political and legal environment, Records and accepted amendments.

In Chapter 3, the advocacy system was presented. An analysis was carried out of the acts constituting the professional self-governing body of lawyers, the organization of the bar associations and the bodies of barristers, including the characteristics of each body; As well as rules, course and conditions of attending lawyer's application.

Chapter 4 describes the practice of attorney practice. The following are included: entry in the list and removal from the list of attorneys, establishment of a registered office, immunity and professional secrecy lawyer's attorney's fees, attorney's fees and the granting of legal aid ex officio. There are also forms of occupation.

Last, Chapter 5 covers the scope of an analysis of rules covering the principles of ethics and dignity of the profession of lawyer, the disciplinary jurisdiction of disciplinary courts and a procedural rule covering disciplinary action.
